JESUS WASHES FEET

Luke 22:24-27 (MSG) *They were bickering over who of them would end up the greatest. But Jesus intervened: "Kings like to throw their weight around and people in authority like to give themselves fancy titles. It's not going to be that way with you. Let the senior among you become like the junior; let the leader act the part of the servant. Who would you rather be: the one who eats the dinner or the one who serves the dinner? You'd rather eat and be served, right? But I've taken my place among you as the one who serves."*

Illustration: A man had a rare disease. The doctor told His wife, “He can live on a very special diet. You will need to cook 3 special meals everyday. The house must be kept spotless; completely germ free. You will be like a servant.” The wife told her husband, “Bad news. You are going to die.”

I’m not going to do that—it’s too much—it’s beneath me. Tap your neighbor and say, “I’m not going to do that.” See. But to love like Jesus, we have to be willing to **forgive**. To love like Jesus, we have to be willing to **serve others**.

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1 Cor. 13:5 AMP **Love does not insist on its own rights or way.**

THE HEART OF A SERVANT

2. Servants do what is **asked**. But my way is better! No! The goal of servanthood is to be a blessing.
3. Servants see a need and **meet it**. Jesus constantly shocked with irrational acts of love. He changed the world!

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Matthew 25:1-40 (NIV) *The Son of Man will come again with divine greatness, and all his angels will come with him Then the king will say to the godly people on his right, “Come, my Father has great blessings for you. The kingdom he promised is now yours It is yours because when I was hungry, you gave me food to eat. When I was thirsty, you gave me something to drink. When I had no place to stay, you welcomed me into your home. When I was without clothes, you gave me something to wear. When I was sick, you cared for me. When I was in prison, you came to visit me” The king will answer, “The truth is, anything you did for any of my people here, you also did for me.”*

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
