The lyrics of "O Come O Come Emmanuel" dates back between the 8th & 12th century. At that time they would read a Psalm then sing or chant a short line beginning with the letter O. This was called "The O Antiphons." One of those lines was, "O Come O Come Emmanuel."

Matthew 1:21-23 (NIV) *"She [Mary] will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: "The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and they will call him Emmanuel"—which means, "God with us."*

Joseph, in the Bible, was beaten, thrown in a pit, sold into slavery, false accused, and you could say, “Where was God?”

Genesis 39:21 (NKJV) *But the LORD was with Joseph and showed him mercy, and He gave him favor.*

God was working behind the scenes, kept promoting Joseph, and ultimately used him to assure Israel's safety.

Genesis 50:20 (NIV) *You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives.*

3) God _____ with you.

Romans 8:35, 37-39 (NIV) *Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus.*

Nothing can separate you—nothing! You will never be alone! God is, God was, and God will *always* be with you.



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What does it mean for God to be with us?

- God is NOT a distant **uninvolved** Creator.
- God is NOT just **watching over** you.

The phrase, "God with us" reveals God is a **relational God**.
