**2 Kings 6:1-7 (NCV)** *The groups of prophets said to Elisha, "The place where we meet with you is too small for us. Let's go to the Jordan River. There everyone can get a log, and let's build a place there to live . . . ." When they arrived at the Jordan, they cut down some trees. As one man was cutting down a tree, the head of his ax fell into the water. He yelled, "Oh, my master! I borrowed that ax!" Elisha asked, "Where did it fall?" The man showed him the place. Then Elisha cut down a stick and threw it into the water, and it made the iron head float. Elisha said, "Pick up the axhead." Then the man reached out and took it.*

**John 2:1-5 (MSG)** *Three days later there was a wedding in the village of Cana in Galilee. Jesus' mother was there. Jesus and his disciples were guests also. When they started running low on wine at the wedding banquet, Jesus' mother told him, "They're just about out of wine." Jesus said, "Is that any of our business, Mother—yours or mine? This isn't my time. Don't push me." She went ahead anyway, telling the servants, "Whatever he tells you, do it."*
