## **OUR KNOWLEDGE OF OUR ENEMY**

Much of what we believe about the devil has been mixed with the views of Judaism. There is a spiritual bond between Christianity and Judaism. Like Christianity, Judaism begins with the covenant God made to Abraham. However, Judaism rejects Jesus as Messiah, along with His teachings. In so doing, they trap themselves in an Old Testament perspective.

**2 Corinthians 3:14 (NKJV)** *Their minds were blinded. For until this day the same veil remains unlifted in the reading of the Old Testament, because the veil is taken away in Christ.*

The New Testament is in the Old Testament **concealed**.  
The Old Testament is in the New Testament **revealed**.

**Hebrews 1:1-3 (NIV)** *In the past God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets at many times and in various ways, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom also he made the universe. The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being.*

5. We begin to **speak** his lie.

We can put an end to Satan's reign in our lives, by simply following Jesus' example:

- Submit yourself to God and **forgive**.
- **Resist** the enemy and his lies.
- We put **God's truth** in your mouth.
