The Bible clearly teaches that faith (or trusting God) involves both believing and speaking. For faith to work properly it must be in your **heart** and in your **mouth**. Why? Because Heaven responds to your voice.

Daniel 10:12 (NKJV) *Then he said to me, "Do not fear, Daniel, for from the first day that you set your heart to understand, and to humble yourself before your God, your words were heard; and I have come because of your words."*

Your voice moves Heaven. It also moves **mountains**.

Mark 11:22-23 (NKJV) *Have faith in God. For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.*

Your words not only moves mountains, they also determine the **course** and **direction** of your life.
