Chapter 1: Paul introduces two gospels: grace and works/law.

Chapter 2: Paul deals with people swinging back and forth.

- Crucify Self: Others before self. Selfish to selfless.

Chapter 3: Paul begins to re-explain the gospel. He brings people back to Abraham: to salvation by promise, not law.

Abraham to Moses was 430 years.

Internal.

GOD'S FREE GIFT

1. Salvation is a **free gift**. You can't earn this.

Romans 6:23 (NIV) *The wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.*

2. This gift is received by **faith**.

Ephesians 2:8-9 (NIV) *For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast.*

3. This gift is available to **everyone**. Everyone can come and allow God to do His work on the inside of them.

Romans 10:13 (NIV) *Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.*

4. This gift comes only through **Christ**. Jesus is the only one who dealt with the problem.

Romans 5:15 (NCV) . . . *many people have received God's gift of life by the grace of the one man, Jesus Christ.*

John 14:6 (NIV) *I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.*

Acts 4:12 (NIV) *Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved."*

5. This gift **changes** us.

Titus 2:11-12 (NIV) *For the grace of God has appeared that offers salvation to all people. It [the grace of God] teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age.*
